The New You

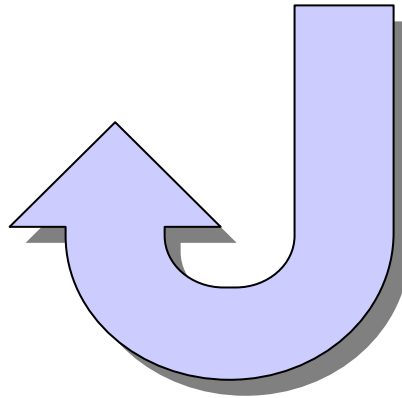
