What are some things we can do for God that benefit others?

**Parable of the Lost Sheep** 15:1-7 1093  
How can we be like the Pharisees?  
We need to rejoice in others coming to Jesus.

**Parable of the Lost Coin** 15:8-10 1094  
The silver coin is a Drachmas, worth a days wages.  
Just imagine the rejoicing in Heaven when we were (or become) saved.

**Parable of the Pharisee and the Tax Collector** 18:9-14 1097  
Describe the attitudes of the two people praying.  
Can saved people have a similar attitude today?
