
### **Biblical Facebook Posting Guidelines for Born Again Believers**

1. What we type with our keyboard is the same as what we would say with our mouth. May everything we as born again believers post on Facebook be truly pleasing to God.

*Psalm 19:14. May these words of my mouth and this meditation of my heart*

*... be pleasing in your sight,  
LORD, my Rock and my Redeemer.*

2. What we perceive to be Biblically permissible may trouble another believer, therefore we need to prayerfully consider if what we are thinking about posting is worth that risk. Plus, it could turn off an unbeliever who is looking carefully at you to see if you are living a life that shows a true love for God.



1 Corinthians 8:9. *Be careful, however, that the exercise of your rights does not become a stumbling block to the weak.*

3. Believers are not look to the stars for the future, but rather to God who created the stars. Therefore believers should never be posting anything to do with Astrology.

*Deuteronomy 4:19. And when you look up to the sky and see the sun, the moon and the stars—all the heavenly array—do not be enticed into bowing down to them and worshiping things the LORD your God has apportioned to all the nations under heaven.*

4. Avoid negative postings. These do not show the believer as a person that knows Jesus. Let others know that we are for Jesus before they know what we are against.


*2 Timothy 2:23. Don't have anything to do with foolish and stupid arguments, because you know they produce quarrels.*

5. We who know Jesus are to be so focused on reaching out to others, including politicians, that we have no room for the astounding hatred that some believers have towards some in office. Those watching us need to see a true Agape love in our hearts for all.

*2 Timothy 2:4 No one serving as a soldier gets entangled in civilian affairs, but rather tries to please his commanding officer.*

6. This sums up what our postings should show, a heart so filled with Christ's love that there would no desire for anything that would bring dishonor to God.

*Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. 2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.*
